Weekly Reading

This Weekly Reading activity can be used as a homework assignment or an in-class daily activity exercise. There are five different weekly sheets that cover five categories, plus one blank template to create your own. These are the five categories:

- 1. Character Analysis
- 2. Creative Thinking
- 3. Critical Thinking
- 4. Language Analysis
- 5. Visual Imagery

Each activity sheet can be used throughout a book or reading exercise. It can also be used at the end of a book.

How to use each activity sheet:

- 1. Before giving out each sheet, make sure to place a value amount in the box marked, "Value".
- 2. Students complete the activity for a specific day by righting their responses underneath the activity. Students can write more for each activity on the back of sheet if they run out of room in the space provided.
- 3. The teacher corrects each response and gives the student the value amount in the "Deposit" box.
 - Variation: If the answer is only partially accurate, a partial value amount can be given.
- 4. If the activity for that day is not completed, the value amount is placed in the "Withdraw" box.
- 5. Students keeps a balance tally after every deposit or withdraw.
- 6. The balance showing on the last day will be deposited into the student's account or if you are still using play money, that money amount is given to the student.
